Students are to go outside for recess before school starts, at lunch, and afternoon recess unless kept inside due to "other" circumstances. Please make sure your child has the proper attire when coming to school. There is a pattern starting already where we are seeing many students wondering the halls, cafeteria, and even hiding in the bathroom because they don't want to go outside due to the weather. Boots will soon be required, as well. This issue needs to be "nipped in the bud" right away. Please discuss the rules with your child.

When a student is absent, he/she has one day per absenteeism to make up their work. <u>Literacy Tips:</u> Have students practice their spelling in clay, using magnetic letters, or typing them on a computer. Read with your child daily to ensure he/she is being fluent and understanding what is being read. **Reading books and/or library books should be coming home to practice reading daily.**

<u>Math Tips:</u> All students have been added to a new math program call "front row." Students can access the program from home and continue where they left off. The classroom code is 3s3trg. This is a great way to work on all skills learned thus far and MATH FACTS!
